Various schemes including a roundabout, staggered cross roads and cattle grids have been proposed but none have been actioned. Numerous accidents have occurred, some serious.</b> BPC wrote to our County Councillor to at least ask H.Highways to replace GIVE WAY signs with STOP signs. Site meeting with H.Highways on 10 December 2018. STOP signs agreed. Email received via Cllr White. Daniel Hutchings (Senior Road Safety Engineer) is due to progress this scheme. Report of Royal Mail Post Van 'lost' at the Cross roads Final Plans received from HantsCC Engineer (via Roger Bell). Work expected "during the summer" A further RTI (RTA!) at these cross roads noted in the past few days. Cllr Moore has asked for more details of installation Stop signs now in place. Surfacing and painting reported as complete at BPC meeting. Small (but NOT mini) roundabout or staggered X-roads as next step
