Highways Sub-Group - December 2023 Report

1. Reporting Highways Issues - Please continue to report highways issues – potholes, flooding, damaged signs, hedge encroachment to Hampshire County Council:

Potholes have been appearing (and re-appearing) on many of the busier roads – we have reported on Boldre Lane; Pilley Hill; Hundred Lane; Bull Hill etc

Flooding issues have also affected and been reported in Royden Lane, Boldre Lane, Main Road and Hundred Lane. The flooding in Portmore has resulted in a householder having his home flooded twice within 3 days. These flooding issues are recurrent and require significant highways and drainage work.

2. Works Done – some issues have finally been addressed / resolved: Filling and Repairs in the centre of B3054 Walhampton Hill Rodlease Lane – a delicate safety rail has been constructed.

- **3. Safety at Portmore 5 Ways** Safety at this junction was raised at a recent BPC Meeting. The sub-group raised this with a variety of figures at HCC. The one response was to the effect that safety work at such junctions would only follow a record of significant accidents. No accidents have been recorded at this site in the last five years. - **4. Heavy Goods Vehicles** using Hundred Lane in Portmore remain a problem damaging the road, edges and infrastructure, while some have caused significant problems by getting stuck!
